

Itinerary for typical Delta Cruise and Adventure

- 1) Leg One; Leaving from Richmond Yacht Club
 - a) Flood tide; early morning if possible
 - b) Checklist for trip:
 - 1) Water topped off
 - 2) Batteries topped off and serviced
 - 3) Oil and engine checks
 - 4) Fuel topped off
 - 5) Electronics checked (i.e. radio, GPS, Chartplotter, instruments, etc.)
 - 6) Anchor rode paid out and ready for use
 - 7) Extra line prepared for deployment (for shoreline trees, other cruisers, extra fenders)
 - 8) Food, drinks, etc.
 - 9) Dinghy secured (fuel topped off; engine test run)
 - 10) Water toys packed

Arrive at first destination

- a) Vallejo (approx. 3 hours)
- b) Benicia (approx. 4 hours)
- c) Martinez (approx. 4 hours)
- d) Pittsburg (approx. 5 hours)
- e) Decker Island (approx. 6 hours)
- f) Antioch (approx. 6 hours)

- 2) Leg Two; Leaving from Antioch or Decker Island

Arrive at Second Destination

San Joaquin River (Central Delta and Delta Loop)

- a) Bethel Island resorts and anchorage (2.5 hours)
- b) Potato Slough anchorage (approx. 3.5 hours; Decker Island 2.5 hours)
- c) Owl Harbor/Bruno's/Spindrift (approx. 3 hours; Decker Island 2 hours)
- d) Korth's Pirate's Lair/Willow Berm (approx. 3.5 hours)
- e) Tinsley Island, Disappointment Slough area (approx. 4 hours)
- f) King Island area (approx. 4 hours)
- g) Ox Bow Marina via Georgiana Slough (approx. 4 hours)
- h) Walnut Grove via Georgiana Slough (approx. 6 hours)
- i) Stockton Sailing Club (approx. 5 hours)
- j) Giusti's Restaurant and boat landing (approx. 6 hours)

San Joaquin River (South Delta)

- a) Whiskey Slough Harbor (4 hours)
- b) Discovery Bay (4 hours)
- c) Bullfrog Landing (3.5 hours)
- d) Stockton Sailing Club (3.5 hours)

Sacramento River (North Delta)

- a) Steamboat Slough anchorage (approx. 5 hours)
- b) Walnut Grove via Sacramento River (approx. 4.5 hours)
- c) Snug Harbor (approx. 4 hours)
- d) Hidden Harbor (approx. 2 hours)
